If a student has, or will be earning, an Associate of Arts or a Bachelor's (e.g., BA, BS, BBA, etc.) Degree from a regionally accredited institution prior to matriculation, any incomplete prerequisite general education courses in English (with the exception of English Composition), Humanities, Social/Behavioral Sciences, will be waived.

****Please note:** the above prerequisite courses are required for admittance to the DKICP PharmD program. If a DKICP student desires to earn a Bachelor of Arts in Pharmacy Studies (BAPS) in addition to PharmD, then additional general education courses are needed to be taken to satisfy the BA requirements. The BAPS degree is only available to students currently enrolled at UH Hilo DKICP.
